Safeguarding the environment





Deadline for submitting proposals	17:00 (CEST), 29 August 2025
Evaluation period	from September 2025 (TBD)

^(*) The expression of intent is <u>not</u> a disqualifying requirement, therefore the two-week notice is not a hard deadline. However, for monitoring purposes <u>all applicants are encouraged to express their intent to submit a proposal as soon as possible</u>.

- Official and all communication language of this CfP is English.
- Applicants are requested to use UNIDO's eProcurement portal for the preparation and submission of grant proposals (to be explained today).
- Applicants shall use Q&A function of eProcurement portal for record-keeping and future audit purposes. Direct communication with the project team members by applicants are forbidden.
- Grant proposals shall remain valid for **270 days after the deadline for submission** of grant proposals.

Evaluation Process

- All grant proposals received on time shall be examined and evaluated strictly in accordance with the criteria and methodology described in the CfPs, through the following steps:
- a) Preliminary examination (= review of qualification requirements/criteria)
- b) <u>Technical and financial evaluation, and Ranking the proposals</u>
- c) The "No objection" process for the Project Idea Note (PIN)
 under the JC b/w Japan and the African JCM Partner country
- After evaluation of proposals within UNIDO, the selected applicant's PIN will be submitted to the JC in line with the JCM rules.
- Upon receiving a "No objection" from the JC, the respective proposal will be chosen for grant award.
- It is crucial that stakeholders in host countries are identified and consulted with positive response
 given in advance especially from the relevant JC member(s) of the host country, so that the proposal
 will be smoothly implemented under JCM procedure such as Project Idea Note.


UNIDO eProcurement Portal

UNIDO eProcurement Portal	The UNIDO eProcurement Portal (UNIDO eProcurement system) must be used for: - accessing the complete set of Call for Proposals documents - acknowledging participation by an applicant - accessing clarifications and modifications made to the Call for Proposals - asking questions related to the Call for Proposals before the submission deadline - submission and modification of Grant Proposal/s before the submission deadline Any other means of communication and proposal submission are not accepted by UNIDO and must be avoided. Therefore, applicants are encouraged to register at the UNIDO eProcurement Portal.




