



□ Steering Committee

National Governments such as Ministry of Natural Resources and Environment, Ministry of Energy, Ministry of Foreign Affairs, TGO etc. are <u>member of Steering Committee of</u> <u>Bangkok Master Plan on Climate Change 2021 – 2030</u>

□ Thai-German Cooperation on Energy Mobility and Climate (TGC-EMC) in 2023-2027

TGC-EMC is the joint project between Germany and Thailand to contribute to climate protection and sustainable development and supporting measures for mitigation of GHG emissions. This project consists of 4 organizations including BMA

□ Thailand Climate Action Conference (TCAC)

BMA joined this event in August 2022 to share experiences and implementation on climate change issue and pursuing efforts to achieve net-zero emissions.
