

Model Project for Improvement of Water Environment in Asia

To <u>support the improvement of water environment</u> in Asia-Pacific <u>by disseminating</u> <u>appropriate water treatment and related technologies</u> by Japanese private sectors.



- So far, a total of 34 projects have been approved, and <u>28 projects have been approved in ASEAN countries</u>, one of which is being implemented in Luang Prabang City in Laos.
- Approved projects are in the fields of domestic wastewater treatment, Industrial wastewater treatment, Phosphorus resource recovery system, control of Non-point source pollution.



Model Project for Improvement of Water Environment in Asia

Challenges

- Cooperation of local actors including the governments is key to the smooth project implementation.
- Facilities and O&M cost, strong enforcement of pollution control laws by local governments and capacity development in management, O&M can be challenge for commercialization.
