



At **UN Environment Assembly-1**: For UN Environment Programme to facilitate immediate and coordinated action to address air pollution and its impacts and prepare regional assessment reports on air quality issues.





Member states reiterated the urgent attention needed to address air pollution and role of regional cooperation with the UNEA-6 Resolution: Promoting regional cooperation on air pollution to improve air quality globally

UNEP'S MEDIUM-TERM STRATEGY 2022—2025: ON THE ROAD TO 2030

Air quality target: "By 2025, 30 per cent of the world's population live in areas where WHO Air Quality Interim Target 3 (15µg/m³) for outdoor PM2.5 (fine particulate matter) is attained".








Journey to Clean Air – example of national level support



POLICY AND REGULATORY WORK

- Overall: Developed clean air plan adopted in 2022
- **Transport**: Implementing improved vehicle emission standards
- Agriculture: Resource package on sustainable agriculture practices to address open burning of residues



SCIENCE AND EVIDENCE

- Overall: Quantified cost of inaction on air pollution
- Agriculture: Remote sensing-based approach to monitor CH₄ emissions from paddy rice
- **Textile**: Assessing emissions from boilers in garment factories
- Agriculture: Tier 2 GHG inventory

ADVOCACY AND NETWORKS



PARTNERSHIPS

• **Textiles**: Facilitate identification and development of clean air interventions with climate co-benefits for potential access to climate finance, such as Japan's Joint Crediting Mechanism
