Current domestic regulations on E-waste Management

- 1. Republic Act (RA) 6969: Toxic Substances and Hazardous and Nuclear Wastes Act of 1990
 - covers the sound and proper management of industrial chemicals and hazardous wastes in all aspects of its life cycle
- 2. Department Administrative Order 1992-29
 - Implementing rules and regulations of RA 6969
- 3. Department Administrative Order 1994-28: Interim Guidelines for the Importation of Recyclable Materials Containing Hazardous Substances

Recyclable materials that are allowed to be imported:

- 1. Scrap metals
- 2. Solid plastic materials
- 3. Electronic assemblies and scrap
- 4. Used oil
- 5. Fly-ash

Current domestic regulations on E-waste Management

- 4. Department Administrative Order 2013-22: Revised Procedures and Standards for the Management of Hazardous Wastes
 - Waste Electrical and Electronic Equipment (WEEE) is classified as hazardous waste under waste number M506.
 - Solid plastic materials and electronic assemblies and scraps are allowed to be imported for recycling, as well as secondhand Electrical and Electronic Equipment (EEE) for direct resale/ trading.
 - Hazardous wastes such as WEEE are allowed to be exported for treatment, recovery, and final disposal.

Current domestic regulations on E-waste Management


- 5. DAO 2010-06: Guidelines on the Use of Alternative Fuels and Raw Materials in Cement Kilns
 - -Guideline on the registration and permitting requirements, standards and procedures on coprocessing of alternative fuels and raw materials (AFR) for clinker for cement production.
- 6. DAO 2021-14: Amendment on some provisions of DAO 2010-06: Guidelines on the use of alternative fuels and raw materials in cement kilns
 - -Clarification that all WEEE or e-wastes except dismantled and segregated PBDE-containing plastic wastes are not acceptable for co-processing.

- Registration of TSD Facilities
- Issuance of Permit to Transport and Manifest Form
- Registration of Cement Kiln Co-processing Facility
- Notification and Export Clearance New


- Issuance of Importer Registry Certificate

Amendment of DAO 2013 -22

SALIENT POINTS

- Definition of the following terms:
 - Clustered Hazardous Waste Generators
 - Final Disposal Facility
 - Electrical and Electronic Equipment (EEE)
 - Environmentally Sound Management (ESM) of hazardous waste
 - Materials Recovery Facility
 - Online Hazardous Waste Management System
 - Refurbishment
 - Second -hand or Used EEE
- Addition of Sub-classes:
 - Waste Electrical and Electronic Equipment (M506 A to M506 L)
 - Special wastes (M507 A to M507 M)



Amendment of DAO 2013 -22

SALIENT POINTS

- Extension for storage time limit shall be requested 1 month prior to its expiration
- SMRsubmission shall be quarterly for all HWG Categories
- Integration of the Online Hazardous Waste Management System and OPMS
- Requirements and responsibilities for <u>clustered establishment s</u>
- Guidance for collection events and EPRprograms



Draft policy on E -waste: Guidelines on the ESM of WEEE

Objectives:

- Provide the framework mechanism for the appropriate management of WEEE
- Reduce the amount of electrical and electronic equipment (EEE)type of waste and the hazards brought about by its components
- Promote the reuse of EEE and valorization (placing value or price to) of its waste components
- Encourage involvement of all relevant agencies and stakeholders in the life cycle of EEE
- Institutionalize the principle of "extended producers responsibility" (EPR)


