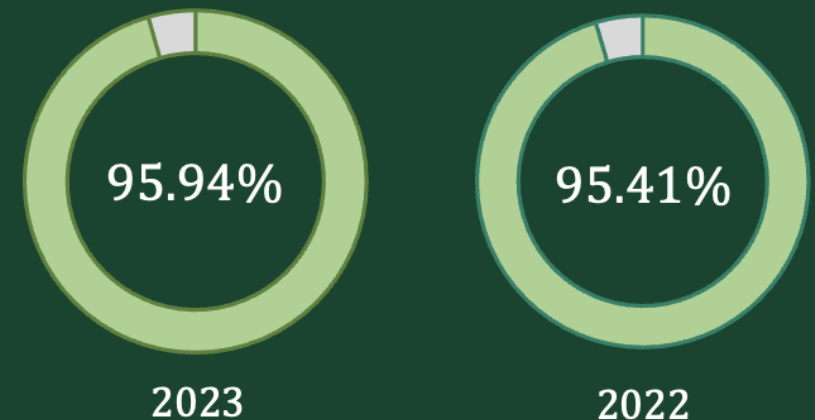

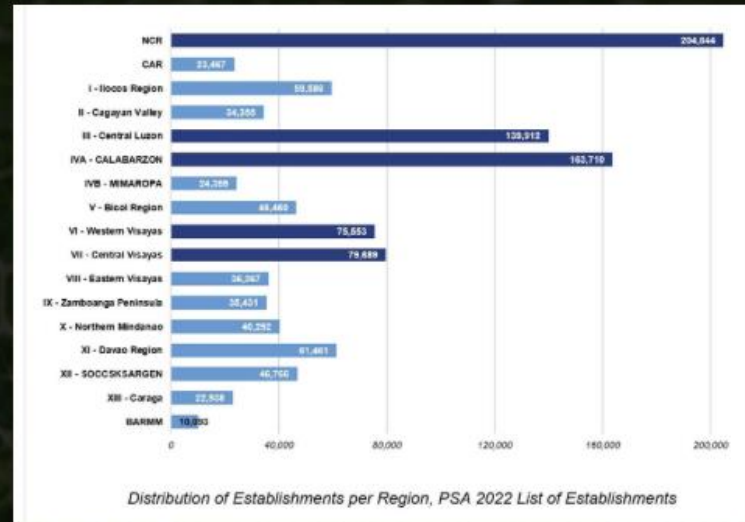
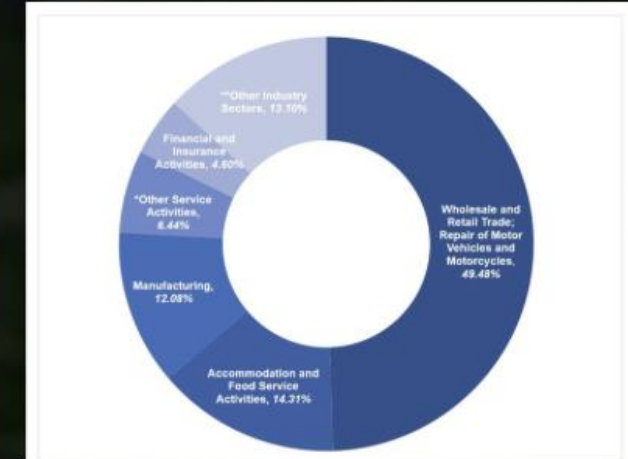
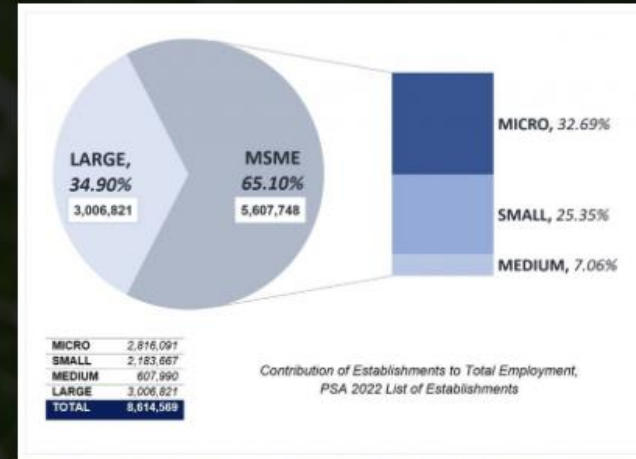
SEC Memorandum Circular No. 4, Series of 2019

- Sustainability Reporting Guidelines for Publicly Listed Companies (PLCs)
 - Promote transparency through sustainability reporting
 - Assist PLCs assess and manage their non-financial performance across Economic, Environmental and Social aspects
 - Enable PLCs to measure and monitor their contributions towards achieving universal targets of sustainability
