- Building business network among Thai and Japanese private sector

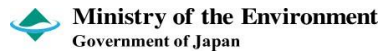

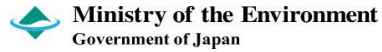

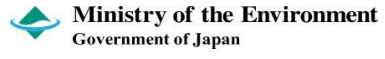
